Open form poetry

You probably read a poem or two at school, he had to memorize a poem at a certain point, or maybe he even wrote a poem yourself. But what exactly is poetry? A good way to think about poetry is considered a word to play. As a painter uses paint or a sculptor uses clay, a poet creatively uses words to make a poem. In this sense, a poet is a word artist. And, as other art forms, creating poetry can be a pleasant or moving experience. He thinks a poem must rhyme, follow a certain format, or be profound and significant. But this is not completely true. While a poem can be one or all of these, it must not be. Instead of thinking in such limiting terms, it is better to think of poetry as a creative form of expression - one who has many tools and is constantly invalent. Most of the text you read and write on a daily basis - novels, essays, newspaper articles, magazines and blogs - are written without a poetic styling. This writing, which is indicated as the prose, is composed of sentences and paragraphs, and usually has just entered a page with little attention to where the lines break and where the words fall. Poetry, on the other hand, It is written for its evocative quality - those qualities that produce an emotional response in the reader or create an experience.
