About the AuthorJames N. Butcher was born in West Virginia. Heenlisted in the army when he was 17 years old and served in theairborne infantry for 3 years, including a 1-year tour in Koreaduring the Korean War. After military service, he attended GuilfordCollege, graduating in 1960 with a BA in psychology. He received anMA in experimental psychology in 1962 and a PhD in clinicalpsychology from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Hewas awarded Doctor Honoris Causa from the Free University ofBrussels, Belgium, in 1990 and an honorary doctorate from theUniversity of Florence, Florence, Italy, in 2005. He is currentlyprofessor emeritus in the Department of Psychology at theUniversity of Minnesota. He was associate director and director ofthe clinical psychology program at the university for 19 years. Hewas a member of the University of Minnesota Pressrsquo;s MMPIConsultative Committee, which undertook the revision of the MMPI in1989. He was formerly the editor of Psychological Assessment, ajournal of the American Psychological Association, and serves asconsulting editor or reviewer for numerous other journals inpsychology and psychiatry. Dr. Butcher was actively involved indeveloping and organizing disaster response programs for dealingwith human problems following airline disasters during his career.He organized a model crisis intervention disaster response for theMinneapolis-St. Paul Airport and organized and supervised thepsychological services offered following two major airdisasters: Northwest Flight 255 in Detroit, Michigan, and AlohaAirlines on Maui. He is a fellow of the Society for PersonalityAssessment. He has published 60 books and more than 250 articles inthe fields of abnormal psychology, cross-cultural psychology, andpersonality assessment. Jill M. Hooley is a professor of psychologyat Harvard University. She is also the head of the experimentalpsychopathology and clinical psychology program at Harvard. Dr.Hooley was born in England and received a BSc in psychology fromthe University of Liverpool. This was followed by research work atCambridge University. She then attended Magdalen College, Oxford,where she completed her DPhil. After a move to the United Statesand additional training in clinical psychology at SUNY Stony Brook,Dr. Hooley took a position at Harvard, where she has been a facultymember since 1985. Dr. Hooley has a long-standing interest inpsychosocial predictors of psychiatric relapse in patients withsevere psychopathology such as schizophrenia and depression. Herresearch has been supported by grants from the National Instituteof Mental Health and by the Borderline Personality DisorderResearch Foundation. She uses fMRI to study emotion regulation inpeople who are vulnerable to depression and in people who are suffering from borderline personality disorder. Another area ofresearch interest is nonsuicidal self-harming behaviors such as skin cutting or burning. In 2000, Dr. Hooley received the Aaron T.Beck Award for Excellence in Psychopathology Research. She is alsoa past president of the Society for Research in Psychopathology.The author of many scholarly publications, Dr. Hooley was appointedAssociate Editor for Clinical Psychological Science in 2012. She isalso an associate editor for Applied and Preventive Psychology andserves on the editorial boards of several journals including theJournal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology, the Journal ofFamily Psychology, Family Process, and Personality Disorders:Theory, Research and Treatment. In 2015 Dr. Hooley received theZubin Award for Lifetime Achievement in Psychopathology Researchfrom the Society for Research in Psychopathology. At Harvard, Dr.Hooley has taught graduate and undergraduate classes inintroductory psychology, abnormal psychology, schizophrenia, mooddisorders, clinical psychology, psychiatric diagnosis, andpsychological treatment. Reflecting her commitment to thescientist-practitioner model, she also does clinical workspecializing in the treatment of people with depression, anxietydisorders, and personality disorders. Matthew Nock was born andraised in New Jersey. Matt received his BA from Boston University(1995), followed by two masters (2000, 2001) and a PhD from YaleUniversity (2003). He also completed a clinical internship atBellevue Hospital and the New York University Child Study Center(2003). Matt joined the faculty of Harvard University in 2003 andhas been there ever since, currently serving as a Professor in theDepartment of Psychology. While an undergraduate, Matt became veryinterested in the question of why people do things to intentionallyharm themselves and he has been conducting research aimed atanswering this question ever since. His research ismultidisciplinary in nature and uses a range of methodologicalapproaches (e.g., epidemiologic surveys, laboratory-basedexperiments, and clinic-based studies) to better understand howthese behaviors develop, how to predict them, and how to preventtheir occurrence. His work is funded by research grants from theNational Institutes of Health, Department of Defense, and severalprivate foundations. Mattrsquo;s research has been published inover 100 scientific papers and book chapters and has beenrecognized through the receipt of awards from the AmericanPsychological Association, the Association for Behavioral andCognitive Therapies, and the American Association of Suicidology.In 2011 he received a MacArthur Fellowship (aka, Idquo;GeniusGrantrdquo;) in recognition of his research on suicide andself-harm. At Harvard, Matt teaches courses on various topicsincluding psychopathology, statistics, research methods, andcultural diversity. He has received numerous teaching and mentoringawards including the Roslyn Abramson Teaching Award and the PetraShattuck Prize. Susan Mineka, born and raised in Ithaca, New York,received her undergraduate degree magna cum laude in psychology atCornell University. She received a PhD in experimental psychologyfrom the University of Pennsylvania and later completed a formalclinical retraining program from 1981 to 1984. She taught at theUniversity of WisconsinMadison and at the University of Texasat Austin before moving to Northwestern University in 1987. Since1987 she has been a professor of psychology at Northwestern, andfrom 1998 to 2006 she served as director of clinical trainingthere. She has taught a wide range of undergraduate and graduatecourses, including introductory psychology, learning, motivation,abnormal psychology, and cognitive-behavior therapy. Her currentresearch interests include cognitive and behavioral approaches tounderstanding the etiology, maintenance, and treatment of anxietyand mood disorders. She is currently a Fellow of the AmericanPsychological Association, the American Psychological Society, andthe Academy of Cognitive Therapy. She has served as editor of theJournal of Abnormal Psychology (1990mdash;1994). She also served asassociate editor for Emotion from 2002 to 2006 and is on theeditorial boards of several of the leading journals in the field.She was also president of the Society for the Science of ClinicalPsychology (1994mdash;1995) and was president of the MidwesternPsychological Association (1997). She also served on the AmericanPsychological Associationrsquo;s Board of Scientific Affairs(1992mdash;1994, chair 1994), on the Executive Board of the Societyfor Research in Psychopathology (1992mdash;1994, 2000mdash;2003),and on the Board of Directors of the American Psychological Society(2001mdash;2004). During 1997 and 1998 she was a fellow at theCenter for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences atStanford.
