I will start out saying that the game definitely caters to Pay to Win players, but let's remember that it is a mobile game meant to make money. Without making money, we wouldn't have the game at all.That being said, I am 100% free to play, and I've been playing since January 2016. This is easily my favorite mobile game, and one of my favorite games in general. Very few games have the staying power of this game, with the strategy and game modes that keep gameplay fresh. New characters regularly added, and I get to play as my favorite Star Wars characters. It's great! Even as a free to play player, I am able to successfully play and WIN many battles. I consistently get 1st or 2nd place in the tournament system (called Grand Arena) and I'm consistently in the top 200 of the PvP arena (even when playing against other players that have been playing as long as I have and have payed to win). If you are smart and join a good guild, you can definitely progress and win in the game.The game definitely has a heavy level of "the grind" but that doesn't stop it from being enjoyable. The early game starts you out running, then between player level 45 to 85 it's very grindy and that's where a lot of players get lost, but after level 85, you open a brand new world in the game. If you just push through those middle levels (if you play every day, it takes a month at the very most) then the game becomes such a fun daily thing. I've been playing Star Wars GoH for around 2 years and am a fip player. I just recently rose to level 85 and am finally starting to get some of those great milestone achievements. However, I must warn that to all players who don't spend money on games, getting good at this particular one is going to take a lot of time and commitment. Leveling up is rather tough once you start to get to some higher levels and many of the people who do spend money can just buy the relatively new hyperspace bundle which gives a bunch of characters and bumps them to max level. Doing that without buying it takes about a year or so if you are staying on top of the daily quests and even then it's a bit of a stretch. However, once you are st max level the game gets very fun. You can start to build select squads and join guilds to compete in special events. Although everything is much easier by paying (as you would expect), once you get to a certain point it's still interesting to play and you can compete against those who do pay. The one thing you will probably never get to equal in without paying is your galactic power as it took me over a month just to get my Jedi squad to at least gear 12. To conclude, I definitely recommend this app to everyone as it is very enjoyable with the many features it has to offer. Just remember the commitment you must offer in return to enjoy everything. It is meant for a slow yet escalating manner of playing. Players can win through free-to-play as much as they can win through pay-to-play. Players who are looking to cheat will have a hard time, as there are no legit cheats whatsoever that work. Most of it is doable without the use of hacks or mods, and even then, the benefits from these are visible after a bit of time. There are some ways to make life easier while playing the game, and these always take the time and effort to play. Here are some tips on how to maximize your day-to-day playing the game. If played in short bursts, the game rewards players in surprising yet pleasant ways. When playing, the urge to use your strongest from the beginning is there, especially if it includes monster buffers like Chewbacca. But this is wrong and it is advisable to use a dummy team first. Why? Because the AI will go create a tactic for this team instead. You can choose your best team afterward.Develop Your Weaker Squads for Galactic WarsMany players think that the key to complete Galactic Wars lies in having stronger characters. The trick is to pick your battles wisely; in this sense, using weaker characters in the Galactic War will help you reach the Final stages quicker, where you can then use your fresher and stronger squads.By reserving your Sim Tickets, we mean using only a maximum of two per auto-complete battle. Think of it as a strategy for gamblers. You don't bet all your chips on just one number or card. The game rewards more odds to those who wait before cashing in all of their sim tickets, so sim wisely!Use the Auto-PilotThis feature is a large part of the game. Star Wars: Galaxy of Heroes rewards those who are frequent players. Even PTP (pay-to-play) players are not safe from grinding. Using the Auto-Battle will help in speeding up the tedious repetition. You might even end up learning how to use your team's positive buffs properly through this tactic.FTP (free-to-play) players should finish their daily activities. It's like a checklist for what must be accomplished for the day. After completing all the activities and meeting the requirements, rewards await at the end of every challenge. Use these rewards to strengthen your team so you could compete with the best or manage to climb the ranks.Cater to VaderMost of you must have your eyes set on the Sith Lord that's more machine than man. Rightfully so, Darth Vader is a monster in the game. He's a monster to unlock but he's also a monster in battle. Working to unlock him isn't just for building a Sith team of past and present Darths. It's also to get his abilities, which are a benefit to any team that has him, Sith, or mixed.Don't forget to download Star Wars™: Galaxy of Heroes for your PC!If you're an avid player, you'll know that the redeemed Jedi Knight Revan is found in the game alongside Bastila Shan, the stalwart Jedi companion and prominent user of the Battle Meditation Force power.What's special about Bastila is that she comes with another character from the famed Star Wars: Knights of the Old Republic series, Jolee Bindo. Bastila is no ordinary Jedi herself, aligning with the Jedi Council at the onset of the Jedi Civil War. She also fought against no less than the then-Darth Revan and his fallen apprentice, Darth Malak. Bastila is also one of the first Jedi characters you'll come across when playing KOTOR.Bindo, meanwhile, is a Coruscant Jedi Temple-trained Jedi. He is a tough-as-nails master of the Force, but his past forced him to break away from all things connected to the formal Jedi Council. He lived informally as a Jedi Master-in-exile on the planet Kashyyyk, mastering all there is to know about its dangerous fauna and fascinating flora. This is where the team led by the redeemed Jedi Revan finds him, and he reluctantly joins the team, giving advice only if it is needed.Shan yields her signature double-bladed lightsaber into battle, and most of her skills and spells are close to her skills as a user of the Battle Meditation ability. In the game, she is a support Jedi, with most of her buffs and abilities a big benefit for heavy Jedi users.Meanwhile, Jolee Bindo is a healer-support Jedi in this game. He's as close as he can be to his personality in KOTOR. He is a guy who means well and is ready to help but is more than willing to have others join in the battle at his expense. He more than makes up for that with his ability, which is to level the playing field for his Jedi companions by reviving them when they fall.Revan is a Jedi that's interesting to cover. His fall from the light to the dark, and rising back to the light, is well-documented in KOTOR. That's why in this PC game, the Jedi Knight is shown wearing his end-game Light Side gear - the Star Forge robes that are only available as Light Side implements and his mask.He is shown donning his famous mask because the developers wanted his character as close as possible to his KOTOR self. In KOTOR, only players knew what his face looked like through designing it from the start. That is why in Galaxy of Heroes, he wears the mask he wore from his fall, and his succeeding return to the light once more.These character updates are only the latest so far.
