Using the Organize Pages tool, you can Rearrange, Extract, Insert, Replace and Split PDF pages. To begin, open the file that you wish to alter. Click the Tools menu and then the Organize Pages to the order desired. Extract Pages to the order desired. Extract Pages to extract a page, or set of pages. Select the Extract Tool. Select your first page to extract by Clicking it, then Control Click any additional pages desired. If desired, you may delete the extracted pages from the original file, or extract the selected pages as separate files by placing a check in the option boxes. Click the Extract button. Insert PagesYou may insert new pages into your PDF file from a File, Clipboard, Scanner, Web Page, a blank page.To insert from a file:Click the Insert tool.Click the From File option.Browse to the location within the destination PDF file to insert the selected file. You can choose Before, or After, from the Location drop down list. Then, choose the start page of the insertion. Click Ok.Replace a PageTo replace a page, or set of pages, in your PDF: Click the page that you would like to replacement. If you choose two pages to replace, two sequential pages of the new PDF file will be imported. Browse to the location of the PDF file that you would like to use as the replacement and select it. Enter the starting, and ending, page number from the replacement PDF file that you would like to use as the replacement and select it. Enter the starting page number in the destination PDF file that you would like to use as the replacement pages. Click Ok. Splitting a PDFYou may split a PDF into separate PDF files based on Number of Pages, File Size, or by the Top Level Bookmarks. To split your PDF: Choose a Split By option from the drop down list. In this case, I am going to split my PDF files. Click the gear icon and choose the Output Options. Click the Split button. The documents are saved according to your chosen output options. There are several other tools that you can use in the Organize Pages tool set, but we will save those for another time. If you do not currently have Adobe Acrobat Pro DC installed, you may download the Adobe Creative Cloud package from the Software@WFU website (WFU login required). When you're using PDF files to submit projects for client approval, send information to vendors for estimation or quotation, or supply samples of your work to prospective customers, you may need to share only a single page out of a much longer document. Rather than compile a separate single-page PDF or send the entire multi-page document, you can use Adobe Acrobat's page-extraction capabilities to create a separate file that holds only the pages, with most pages. The AutoSplit<sup>™</sup> plug-in offers a powerful way for deleting pages from PDF documents by specifying a list of individual pages and page ranges. This operation is also available in Action Wizard (Acrobat's batch processing tool) and can be used for automating of document processing workflows. The instructions below consist of two parts. The first part explains how to delete pages by specifying pages both directly and indirectly. Deleting Page Ranges Step 1 - Open a PDF File Start Adobe® Acrobat® application and open a PDF file using "File > Open..." menu. Step 2 - Open "Delete Pages and page ranges that needs" below the main Acrobat® menu. Step 3 - Specify Pages to Delete Pages and page ranges that needs to be deleted. Pages can be specified either directly as absolute page numbers or indirectly via bookmarks, named destinations or page labels. Absolute page ranges can be specified. For example, type: 1,3,10-14. This will delete pages 1,3,10,11,12,13,14 from the PDF document. The order of the pages in the list of page ranges is not important. Reference Pages By Bookmarks: Enter "b:" keyword followed by a bookmarks: Enter "b:" keyword followed by a bookmarks: Enter "b:" keyword followed by a bookmark name that goes to the page to specify page numbers indirectly via bookmarks. Reference Page By Page Labels: Enter "1:" keyword followed by a page labels. For example, the following instruction will delete pages in PDF document with the page labels "i" and "14": "1:i,1:14". Use all Keywords: Mix and match keywords to delete pages using any of the available page reference methods. Use absolute page numbers, bookmarks, named destinations or page labels simultaneously. Click "OK" to start deleting process. Step 4 - Inspect the Results AutoSplit<sup>™</sup> would remove specified pages from the PDF document.
